This one of a kind programme offers placements in various practices across the UK. Giving you the opportunity to work alongside a plethora of highly respected registered veterinary nurses and veterinary surgeons, including specialists and leaders in their field, in a location that suits you.

You will rotate around a variety of disciplines giving you a broad knowledge of many veterinary nursing specialisms including core rotations such as wards, theatre including anaesthesia and diagnostics as well as PRP centre specific rotations such as dentistry.



PRECEPTORSHIP AND SUPPORT

The programme is a preceptorship, which involves the pairing of a more experienced nurse (preceptor) to a new or less experienced nurse (preceptee). Preceptorship as a clinical learning method has been adopted by many in healthcare sectors, including nursing, pharmacy and dentistry across various countries. A successful partnership between preceptor and preceptee can improve job satisfaction, contribute to nursing retention and improve the quality of nursing care.

From day one, you will be assigned a preceptor (a clinical mentor) readily available for support. Further support is provided by your carefully selected specialist-led referral practice, your peers on the programme and the Linnaeus veterinary nursing team.
